## State of Alarm by Mark Anderson



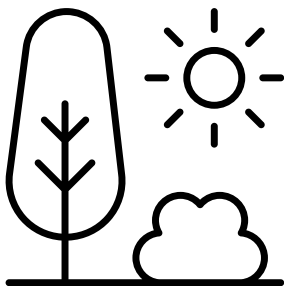
The event is at High Angle Battery, New Ground, Portland, UK///bricks.handbags.defended

The artwork is outside, so prepare for bad weather. Portland can be windy.

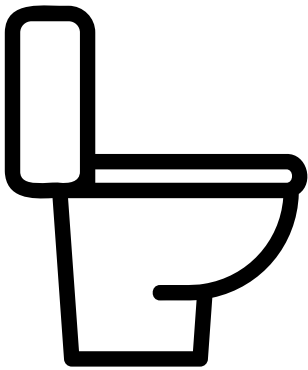


There may be hot weather, so prepare with sunscreen, a sun hat, and a water bottle.

There will be some uneven ground in places.



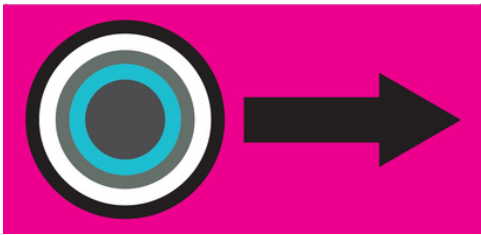
There will be trip hazards so be careful.

You can access the artwork by walking, cycling, going on a public bus or driving.

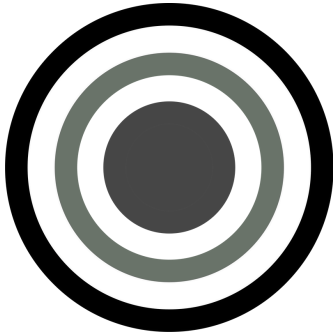


We have put up signs to help you find the artwork.
